

Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports

New Coaches Orientation

Participants will gain an awareness of the philosophical underpinnings of PBIS, the role of coaches in the PBIS implementation process, gain an understanding of the skills needed for effective coaching, and the role of coaches in the use of data for decision making. Participants will network among other coaches and become acquainted with PBIS assessment tools. Coaches will identify three strengths and three areas that need improvement in their school-wide plan based on their reports and create an ongoing action plan to be utilized with the universal team during Tier 1/Universal training.

Target Audience: Internal Coaches at the Universal level, External Coaches, Administrators
