

Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports

Universal Tier 1 Training

Team Building Training: The school PBIS Team, including administrator and coaches, participate in these two training days which consists of intense, interactive activity-based preparation for implementation of school-wide PBIS. These are guided team work days to begin developing the materials needed for PBIS Kick-Off and implementation.

Target Audience: Building level universal team that includes: building administrator, external and internal coaches, regular education teachers that represent grade levels, special education teacher, social worker and/or psychologist, specials teacher, paraprofessional and family members.

Participants should bring:

- ◆ Forms and processes related to discipline policy and practices
- ◆ School Assessment Survey (SAS)
- ◆ Discipline data
- ◆ Laptop for team use

Objectives: Understand the essential components of school-wide positive support systems that provide behavior supports to all students.

- ◆ Review discipline data (Big Five graphs) and begin the process of data-based decision-making to meet student needs
- ◆ Review the impact of student behavior on academic outcomes
- ◆ Discuss and plan school-wide practices and procedures that encourage students to engage in positive behavior and discourage problem behavior
- ◆ Identify 3-5 school-wide behavioral expectations/rules
- ◆ Begin to develop definitions of school-wide behavioral expectations by location (matrix)
- ◆ Begin process of turning new behavioral expectations/rules into teachable lesson plans
