## Day 1

**Beginning GOLD Implementation: Teaching Strategies GOLD Toolkit Learning Objectives** 

#### **Session Description:**

On the first day participants will be introduced to the components and structure of Teaching Strategies GOLD™. Through video clips, activities, and large-group discussions, participants will explore the progressions of development and learning for children from birth through kindergarten. Participants will also learn how to interpret the corresponding color bands and apply the GOLD™ objectives to their observation-based assessments. Participants will practice using the four-step assessment cycle, evaluating a child's portfolio and developing a conference form to share with families. By the end of the first session, teachers will have the basic skills required to begin implementing the Teaching Strategies GOLD™ Assessment Toolkit.

## Day 2

### Implementing the Creative Curriculum System for Preschool Learning Objectives

#### **Session Description:**

The second day is a highly interactive session to help participants at all levels implement *The Creative Curriculum System for Preschool* in their classrooms. Participants will first become familiar with the 38 objectives for development and learning that inform every aspect of teaching. They will then explore and practice using all of the pieces that make up the System: *Knowledge-Building Volumes, Teaching Guides, Mighty Minutes, Intentional Teaching Cards*, and *Book Discussion Cards*.
