Description

Educators recognize the need for timely, effective nonviolent intervention with students who exhibit challenging behaviors. They know that such intervention improves the physical safety of all participants and creates a more trusting and caring learning environment.

Anyone who may have to manage verbally or physically aggressive individuals will benefit from the skills and techniques learned in Nonviolent Crisis Intervention. The content of this workshop addresses the Act 125 requirements regarding the appropriate use of seclusion and restraint.

Workshop Objectives

- 1. Identify the potential for violent or disruptive behaviors
- 2. Reduce tensions
- 3. Prevent violent episodes
- 4. Intervene safely in violent situations
- 5. Develop safe humanistic approaches to crisis intervention
- 6. Improve staff confidence and boost morale
- 7. Provide optimum care for individuals
- 8. Identify the new requirements regarding the use seclusion and restraint in Wisconsin

Who should attend?

Regular and special education professionals and paraprofessionals working with students with challenging behaviors, including teachers, principals, school counselors, social workers, psychologists and other educational specialists. (This training is not recommended for parents.) Prerequisite: Attendance at NVCI Initial Training within the last 18 months.
