Reviewing K-5 Universal Reading Instruction

This THREE-DAY, TEAM-BASED workshop provides literacy leadership teams the capacity to improve systemic universal reading instruction within their Response to Intervention Framework.

Who Should Attend

- Principal or school leader (**essential**)
- General education and special education teachers
- Specialists including: Reading Specialist, Curriculum Director, Literacy Coach, Title One Instructors

Outcomes

- Understand the need for a strong systemic foundation built upon organizational trust and common beliefs on reading instruction around the Common Core State Standards.
- Build school level team capacity around comprehensive literacy instruction for ALL students at the school and classroom level.
- Review and outline core reading components from the Common Core State Standards; phonological awareness, phonics, fluency, vocabulary, comprehension, and text complexity.
- Review and outline instructional time, instructional grouping, and universal classroom environment.
- Understand the effectiveness of systemic best practice in universal reading instruction.
- Investigate and discuss high quality systemic universal reading instruction as it relates to the WI-RtI framework.
- Use the SIR, School-wide Implementation Review Tool (High Quality Instruction Section) and component outlines to action plan and improve your school's universal level reading instruction K-5.



Preparation

- Participants should bring documentation of their current reading programs, practices, strategies, and schedules used to deliver K-5 universal reading instruction.

Cost

\$150 per person. Fee covers all three days of training and materials. A light breakfast, lunch, and snack each day is also provided. Texts will be provided.
