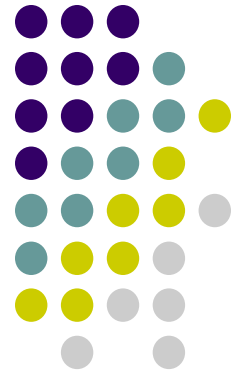

## Best Practices in K-12 Online Instruction

Even though DPI has repealed the 30-hour requirement for online instructor certification, teaching in an online learning environment requires a very specific skill set when compared to traditional classroom settings. Online instructors need to develop competencies with digital tools available as well as how to engage students in digitally literate synchronous and asynchronous classroom conversations. This course will explore specific content, web-based tools, online teaching pedagogy and best practices, challenges/barriers and effective teaching strategies in an online learning environment. *Participants will need a Google account (personal or professional) with Google + enabled.*
