



What is a Chromebook?

- While you may have heard of Google's Chrome browser, have you heard about Chrome OS?
- Chrome OS is Google's browser-based operating system.
- The idea is simple: If we spend ninety percent of our time on the web, why not just go straight to the web and skip all the stuff in-between?

Why use a Chromebook?

- A Chromebook is a personal computer running Chrome OS as its operating system. The devices are designed to be used while connected to the Internet and support applications that reside on the Web, such as Google Apps for Education, rather than traditional applications that reside on the machine itself.
- The Chrome Web Store provides thousands of "web apps" and "extensions"; applications that run in your browser.
