

Math Box Workshop

During this workshop, we will discuss the philosophy and rationale behind students using math boxes during your math block. Organizational tips for your math hour will be covered, including how to introduce the boxes, creation of "stations" that include math boxes and small group work, and how/when to check and change individual boxes. We will review some assessment protocols, as well as your district's requirements, that can be used to provide data in order to ensure that students' boxes are at their independent skill levels and how this relates to RtI. This data can also be used when creating small groups for differentiated lessons. Participants will learn which standards based activities are a required part of the math box and many activities that can be included in addition to those required ones. Each participant will leave with a binder of activities for your class's math boxes!
