

## ISIS-SWIS Facilitator Training Screening Information

ISIS-SWIS Facilitators are individuals employed by the state/district/region to provide assistance to schools. To obtain ISIS-SWIS, a school must collaborate with an ISIS-SWIS Facilitator. ISIS-SWIS Facilitators have a portion of their workload allocated (e.g. .10-1.0) to the tasks associated with ISIS-SWIS facilitation. ISIS-SWIS Facilitators are trained during a full-day workshop delivered by Certified ISIS-SWIS Facilitator Trainers.

This Training is intended to prepare current SWIS "facilitators" to a) use ISIS-SWIS to coordinate and monitor individualized student support, and b) help their local school teams prepare for and use ISIS-SWIS data for progress-monitoring and decision-making.

The full-day training focuses on (a) readiness, compatibility, and licensing, (b) account set-up and student file set up, (c) data entry and report generation, and (d) using ISIS-SWIS data for progress monitoring and accountability.

## \*\*\*Attendance and participation in the full-day training is required for certification.
