Digital Tools For Writing Across The Curriculum

April 21 – May 19, 2014

In this 4 week online course, participants will explore online tools that support educators to bring innovative teaching and learning experiences to students in the classroom.

Participants will research and discuss ways to use these tools to support instruction that empowers students to thrive as a productive learner, worker and citizen. Participants will discuss best practice examples and methodologies for assessing the impact of these tools on writing across the curriculum.

This course involves six hours of weekly work that combines readings, interactive learning games, discussion groups, weekly Elluminate sessions and practical assignments delivered via Moodle. Participants begin with an Elluminate orientation session.

Students will leave this course with concrete plans for using some of the digital tools explored in the classroom, such as Thinglink, Easel.ly, Glogster, StoryJumper, KidBlog and more along with one technology infused lesson plan.
