



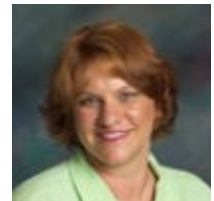
# Foundations in Mentoring and Peer Coaching

Theory for pre-service or in-service training alone does not produce lasting results. - Assist a colleague with formative assessment of their professional practice

- Develop facilitative language and practice collaborative interactions
- Practice listening deeply and foster a disposition of curiosity in the coachee/mentee
- Practice reflection in the 10 teaching standards
- Effectively coach the mentee/coachee in the PDP process
