The Wisconsin Quality Educator Initiative PI 34 requires all school districts to provide a support system for initial educators who complete educator preparation programs after August 2004. The support system must include: ongoing orientation; **support seminars**; a **qualified mentor** for each initial educator; and an administrator who has been **trained in the Professional Development Plan Review** process.

**How to Write a PDP:** These seminars are intended for all Initial Educators in the teacher category after their first full year of teaching or for Professional Educators that want to renew their teaching license using a PDP instead of the old credit system. **PDP Reviewer/Team Training:** Many districts are in need of trained PDP reviewers. The reviewers are responsible for reviewing and approving PDP goals of initial educators and the final PDP. Currently, DPI is finalizing the new requirements of the PDP Team training with intent of that training being offered online. All current PDP reviewers will also have to complete an online refresher.
