PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Fountas & Pinnell Leveled Literacy Intervention System (LLI) is a small-group, supplementary intervention designed for children who struggle with reading and writing. LLI is a short term intervention that is designed to close achievement gaps. LLI can be delivered by the classroom teacher, Title I teacher or reading interventionist, ESL teacher or the special education teacher.

Four systems are available for LLI. Each supports instruction at different levels on the F&P Text Level Gradient™, A-Z:

ASSESSMENT TO DRIVE INSTRUCTION

This training is essential to anyone not familiar with **F&P's Reading Record** or **Continuum of Literacy Learning** as both are vital components of the LLI lesson framework. This training is also for anyone starting out with the BAS kit for the first time. We will learn how to benchmark and progress monitor students including how to administer, score, and analyze the reading record plus how to use the Continuum of Literacy Learning to set learning targets.

**Benchmark Assessment Kit is not required, but it is recommended.*

FRAMEWORK OVERVIEWS

Learn the structure of these systems, practice instructional procedures, and get tips/tricks on getting started.

ORANGE/GREEN/BLUE

LLI's primary kits provide systematic intervention options for students in grades K-3 targeting phonics, fluency, comprehension and writing skills & strategies.

RED/GOLD/PURPLE

LLI's intermediate kits provide intervention options for children in grades 3- 6. These kits teach deeper comprehension skills & strategies along with fluency, word work, and writing. In addition, the kits also include novel studies, genre studies, and test prep.

EXPLORING INSTRUCTIONAL STRATEGIES

During this training, participants will examine, practice, and share instructional strategies to support fluency, word work, writing, and comprehension. We will be using *When Readers' Struggle* and *Comprehending & Fluency* by Fountas and Pinnell to maximize and expand on the instructional strategies within LLI.



MAKING INSTRUCTIONAL DECISIONS WITHIN LLI FRAMEWORK

This workshop is for those who have been trained in and are using LLI. It showcases additional ways to utilize the program, particularly ways to use assessments to examine and share results. Participants will examine teacher language, learn strategies for conferring with readers, practice using the **Prompting Guide**, and explore modifications that can be made for students not making progress.
